1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of Standalone Unaudited Financial Results of Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd. We did not review the interim financial statements/financial information/financial results of subsidiary M/s Visakhapatnam Port Logistics Park Limited, included in the consolidated unaudited financial results, whose interim financial statements/financial information/ financial results reflect total assets of Rs. 17,687.61 Lakhs as at 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 and total revenues of Rs. 478.01 Lakhs & Rs. 864.16 Lakhs, total net loss after tax of Rs. 330.10 Lakhs & Rs. 696.27 Lakhs and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 330.10 Lakhs & Rs. 696.27 Lakhs for the quarter ended 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 & for the period from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2023 to 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2023, respectively, and net cash inflows of Rs. 12.69 Lakhs for the period from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2023 to 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2023, as considered in these consolidated unaudited financial results. This interim financial statements/financial information/financial results have been reviewed by other auditors whose report have been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of the subsidiary is based solely on the report of the other auditor and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above.

According to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, these interim financial statements/financial information/financial results are not material to the Group.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matter.

7. The comparative Ind AS financial information of the company for the preceding quarter ended 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2023, the financial statement of the company prepared as per Ind AS for the quarter and half year ended 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 and the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023, were reviewed/audited by erstwhile auditors, and our opinion on the statement is not modified in respect thereof.

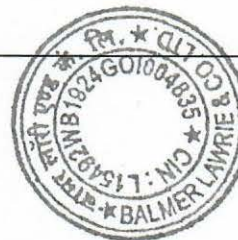

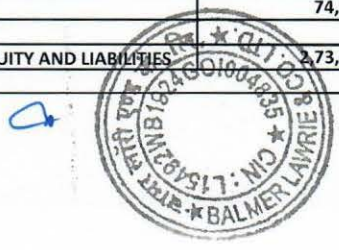
